



The following was part of a recent article entitled "Pivoting To Surrender: A Warning For All Christians", written by R. Albert Mohler Jr., President of The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

The Article says:

"According to the Oxford Languages Dictionary, as a verb, pivot means. 'To turn, as if on a pivot'. It means to change directions...The Christian Church, regardless of denominational ties, has for two millennia been clear on the institution of marriage and family...there is no middle ground between moral revolution and Biblical orthodoxy. Christians must understand this: Pressure is mounting on all fronts and it will confront every single Christian institution, school, congregation, denomination and ministry... Every Christian and every Christian ministry will come to a reckoning—we must all decide here and now where we stand. Will we pivot or will we hold fast to faithfulness and hope of the Gospel?... We are about to find out which institutions, schools, churches and denominations will stand—and who will "pivot" and abandon the faith."

Church family, in this day, where our culture cries, "There is no right, and there is no wrong," we must be the Church, and who God has called us to be, "the voice of one [for one] crying in the wilderness" (John 1:23) declaring the message of righteousness! What God's Word says is right, and what God's Word says is wrong. As a Christian. "to live is Christ" (Phil.1:21). Christ is our standing ground, and He is Enough! Don't pivot away from the "Solid Rock"!

The following is part of a recent news letter from Franklin Graham and the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, sharing concerns over the Equality Act"

"The Equality Act is moving our nation in a direction that elevates government above God. Under its broad reach, the Equality Act will:

- Force schools, churches, and hospitals to accept the government's beliefs and mandates about sexual orientation and gender identity. It could threaten everyday speech, and people can be fined or lose their jobs for using the wrong name or pronouns.
- Allow boys in girls' sports, boys in girls' locker rooms, men in women's shelters, and men in women's prisons. It will force teachers and students to publicly pretend that a biological male is a female, making biological sex (and science) a relic of the past.
- Strip Christian and other religious ministries of their right to hire people of shared faith to pursue a shared mission. Can you imagine a Christian organization bring forced to hire people hostile to its deeply held beliefs?
- Force many doctors and medical professionals to violate their conscience and engage in gender transition treatments such as hormone blocking.
- Threaten accreditation to religious college and universities if they do not apply sexual orientation and gender identity to dorms, sports, places of privacy, and even teachings.

This legislation would massively change our moral landscape and silence people of faith who do not agree with the secular values of the Left.

What can you do? Pray fervently for God to intervene in this matter. Call your senators immediately and ask them to vote NO with conviction to the Equality Act.

In difficult days, we must remember God promised He would always be with His people—those who believe in Him, according to the Scriptures, repent of their sins, receive Him into their lives, and follow Him in obedience. As our country continues to turn further away from God and the Bible, followers of Jesus must work to preserve His truth for future generations."
